Open Source Software (OSS) is a code that is available for public use and can be changed free of charge under an open license. The open source market is mature and can save development time and money, obviating the need to reinvent the wheel. Some banks in India are using/exploring the opportunities of using OSS in their business. The areas where banks could adopt OSS include Mobile Banking, Business Intelligence/ Analytics, Financial Portals (internets and intranets), Contracts/Document/Record Management, Procurement and Invoice Management (including ERP). Shrinking IT budgets, Lack of flexibility, Inability to innovate, and extremely high costs for licenses of proprietary software are some of the reasons why banks in India are exploring new opportunities in OSS.
