Financial Inclusion means extending banking services at an affordable cost to the vast sections of disadvantaged and low-income groups.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has mandated that banks extend their outreach taking banking service to the common man. Extending banking to the rural areas where there are no bank branches, consistent power supply or communication links such as telephones or Internet is a daunting task. One solution that RBI has come up with is to enable customer's intermediate banking facilities through business correspondents who act as agents on behalf of banks.
