Corrigendum 1

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, 4.1.b, the amount of solvency is revised to 50 Lakh from 100 Lakh. It may now be read as follows:

4.1.b. Bank solvency certificate for Rupees **Fifty lakh.**

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, 4.1.f, the amount of average turnover is revised to 100 Lakh from 100% of Estimated Cost. It may now be read as follows:

4.1.f. The average turnover of the contractor for last 3 financial years finding on 31st march of previous financial year should be at **least Rs 100 Lakh.**

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, 4.1.g, the minimum amount is revised from 80% of the estimated cost of the project to projects amounting not less than Rs. 70 Lakh. It may now be read as follows:

4.1.g. Contractor must have completed at least 2 similar works **amounting not less than Rs. 70 lakh** each in last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited, to be eligible to participate in tender.

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, 4.1.h, added “any state or central Govt sector , Quasi-government Organizations, Autonomous Organizations, Statutory Bodies, etc., Set up and funded/controlled by the Central Government and only Listed Private Institutions/bodies in stock exchange.” In the list of eligible organizations. It may now be read as follows:

4.1.h. The works must be of similar nature involving complete interior works for **auditoriums/seminar halls** such as civil works, interior and auditorium acoustic works in walls and roof and electrical works including audio video works for Public Sector Undertakings, Public Sector Banks/Govt. Financial Institutions, **any state or central Govt sector , Quasi-government Organizations, Autonomous Organizations, Statutory Bodies, etc., Set up and funded/controlled by the Central Government and only Listed Private Institutions/bodies in stock exchange** . To prove similar work, the contractor should enclose work order, completion certificates & copy of final sanctioned bill including copy of BOQ and photographs of the interiors of the completed work claimed as similar works.

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, 4.1.i, the amount of penalty is revised to Rs. 23,000 from Rs. 25,000. It may now be read as follows:

4.1.i. The profile of contractor has to be attached with list of completed works and works in hand, tools, personnel, and engineers to be posted at site. The contractor has to post one **Diploma civil engineer of minimum 4 years of experience for entire period of renovation plus 15 days extra during final billing and one diploma electrical engineer with minimum experience of four years would also be posted for entire period of renovation plus 15 days extra during final billing. Non positioning of engineer in respective fields could have penalty of **Rs.23,000 per month, per head.****

- Page No. 6 of Part-1, Added 4.1.j. in the Eligibility Criteria. It reads as follows:

4.1.j. **The eligible works work must have been done by the bidding firm in its own name and no subcontracting and back to back contracting would be considered .**

- Last date of submission of tenders is revised to **31.03.2018 until 1700 Hours** from 28.02.2018.
