Introduction

APIs are entry points or programming artefacts to access a business functionality. They help complete complex processes that are dependent on the business processes of other organisations. APIs are enablers of Straight Through Processing, alleviating the need for cumbersome insecure file upload and download. Banks have been consuming the APIs (Application Programming Interfaces) offered by agencies like AADHAR and NPCI. However, banks may have to open up their APIs such that other businesses can easily develop applications weaving their bank inside their business processes. Web services technology represents an important way for businesses to communicate with each other. While web services (REST) are programmatic interfaces, XML and JSON are the languages that define the data transmitted between the applications. This program focusses on how to design and deploy APIs using latest technologies available.
